Subject: Application dated 25.04.2017 of the Chairman, Sant Gajanan Maharaja Rural Hospital and Research Center, Mahagaon, Tal. Gandhigraj, Distt. Kolhapur Maharashtra to establish new Ayurvedic College in the name of Sant Gajanan Maharaja Ayurved Medical College, Distt. Kolhapur, Maharashtra with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2018-19 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your application vide ref. no. SGMRH & RC/2017-2018/11 dated 25.04.2017 forwarded by Govt. Of India, M/o AYUSH vide letter R-12011/41/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 25.05.2017 on the subject cited above and to say that the physical and other infrastructure facilities available at proposed new college namely **Sant Gajanan Maharaja Ayurved Medical College, Distt. Kolhapur, Maharashtra** was visited on **20.07.2017** by the visitation team of the Central Council of Indian Medicine.

2. The visitation report and all other related papers were placed before the Executive Committee of the Council in its meeting held on 31.07.2017 on careful consideration of the proposal, the Executive Committee decided to recommend for Approval of the Scheme. The decision of the Executive Committee has been approved by the General Body in its meeting held on 31.07.2017 & 01.08.2017. The CCIM has sent the recommendation to the Central government for issuing the Letter of Intent vide letter **Ref. 3-3/2017-Ay.(99) dated 18.08.2017.**
3. Further, in view of the letter of the M/o AYUSH vide ref. No.11011/03/2011 EP(H) Part dated 01.09.2017 wherein mentioned as, *"the Council shall inspect college and issue Letter of Intent (LoI) at their level, if the college is found eligible. The Council shall again inspect/verify the compliance of the conditions of LoI and send the recommendation of either Denial/for issuing Letter of Permission (LoP) as the case may be, only once by 31st March for approval of the Ministry"* and in view of the same, original recommendations of CCIM were sent back to CCIM for taking necessary action at the CCIM's end vide the M/o AYUSH letter No. 11011/03/2017 EP (IM-1) dated 30.1.2018 and the same were placed before the Executive Committee on 30.01.2018 and the EC on careful consideration of the Scheme in terms of the regulation 6 and sub-regulation (2) of regulation 9 of regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003 read with Amendment Regulations of 2013, and provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made there

under, has decided to issue the **Letter of Intent to Sant Gajanan Maharaja Rural Hospital and Research Center, Mahagaon, Tal. Gandhigraj, Distt. Kolhapur Maharashtra to establish a new Ayurved College with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2018-19, under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970** subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before the inspection of the CCIM for issuance of Letter of permission (LoP) for the academic session 2018-19, failing which the recommendation for issuing Letter of Permission (LoP) shall not be sent to the M/o AYUSH, Govt. of India and Letter of Intent (LoI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.

- i. the applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurved Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016";
 - ii. the applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016";
 - iii. the applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013; and
 - iv. the applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970.
4. The applicant is also to submit the requisite Performance Bank Guarantee of **Rupees One Crore** (Rupees One Crore only for upto 60 (UG) seats / Rupees One Crore and Fifty Lakhs for 61-100 (UG) seats) as specified under the section 6 (1) (g) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013".
 5. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the above mentioned UG course till the formal permission by issue of Letter of Permission (LoP) of the Central Government is granted.
 6. The CCIM will visit the proposed college to verify the compliance of the fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant, and recommendations for issuing the LOP will be furnished to the Central Government before 31st March 2018.
 7. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.
 8. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
 9. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
